Traditional: Courses meet in class based on scheduled times and course content and activities are delivered in the classroom setting.

Web-Enhanced: Courses meet in class based on scheduled times. Course content and activities are generally conducted in the classroom, but certain activities and/or additional course content may be delivered/conducted using the Moodle course management system.

Hybrid: Courses meet both online and in class according to a described schedule. Content and assignments are conducted in both modalities.

Online: Courses are conducted entirely online through the Moodle course management system. All activities are conducted electronically.
