Master of Arts in Education completion program for California Credentialed teachers, online (22 Units)

The faculty of the M.A. in Education program recognize the value of the advanced education and unique experiences of teachers. That value is manifested in this completion program by waiver of half the units of the full program. Credentialed teachers with at least one year's full-time teaching experience should not have to take courses that duplicate the knowledge they already have. Earning a California teacher credential is a lot of hard work – courses, TPAs, observations, reflective essays, student teaching, the lesson plans, etc. On top of all that, teaching is also learning and should be recognized as such. To complete the M.A. in Education, teachers take two core courses (8 units) and a set of elective courses (14 units).
