M.A. in Education Online Completion Program for Nevada Teachers

The faculty members of the M.A. in Education program recognize the value of the advanced education and unique experiences of teachers. That value is manifested in this completion program by providing credit for half the units of the full program.

Teachers should not have to take courses that duplicate the knowledge they already have. Earning a teaching license is a lot of hard work – courses, Praxis, observations, reflective essays, student teaching, lesson plans, etc. On top of all that, teaching is also learning and should be recognized as such.

For prior learning, licensed teachers (K-8, 7-9, 7-12) are credited 22 units toward the program. To complete the M.A. in Education online program, Nevada teachers take six courses (22 units).

EDUC 301 Research Methods, 4 units

EDAD 347 Program Planning for Educators, 2 units

EDUC 396 Capstone I: Research Contexts, 4 units

EDUC 397 Capstone II: Gathering and Processing Data, 4 units

EDUC 398 Capstone III: Analysis and Conclusions, 4 units

One of the Following:

EDUC 305 History of American Education, 4 units

EDAD 339 Federal Law and Policy in Education, 4 units

The three-course capstone focuses on developing an individualized, student-chosen, education-related program, such as an after-school math or reading program, a sports team fund raising program, or a PBIS program, among many other possibilities.

All courses are 100% online and do not require being online at specific, pre-set times. The program can be completed in a year, though taking a little longer is advised. Here's a sample schedule:
