#### **Course Modality**

**Blended:** Courses meet virtually on Zoom at the regularly scheduled class day and time, **6:15-9:45 PM**. In addition, students may attend classes on campus, according to COVID protocols outlined by the University.

**Hybrid:** Courses meet both online and virtually on Zoom, if indicated, according to a described schedule. Content and assignments are conducted in both modalities. Hybrid A Virtual meetings begin Week 1; Hybrid B Virtual meetings Week 2. Class time is scheduled for **6:15-9:45 PM**.
