



SELF-HELP SERVICES FOR “EXPUNGEMENT”

WHAT: Law students under the supervision of a licensed attorney will assist in the preparation of forms for what is commonly known as expungement.

WHEN: 7:00 PM Tuesday, Jan 15, Feb 19, 2019;

WHERE: Drivon School of Law, Humphreys University located at 6650 Inglewood Avenue, Stockton, CA 95207 in the Law School Courtroom.

CHECKLIST: To be eligible for an expungement you **must** meet the following conditions:

*You have fulfilled **ALL** conditions of probation for the entire period of probation or have been discharged from probation prior to the termination.

*If there was **no** grant of probation and one year has elapsed from the date of pronouncement of judgment and you have fully complied with the sentence of the Court.

*Any fines and any restitution ordered as a result of your conviction **must be paid in full** prior to filing a request for expungement.

*You are **not** currently serving a sentence on any other case.

*You are **not** currently charged with a law violation.

*You are **not** currently on probation on any other case.

*You must **bring** a copy of your criminal history record (RAP sheet) (case number, conviction date, court location and section violated)

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION: The self help clinic operates on **first come, first served** basis. There will be no appointments or telephone service at this location.
