ONLINE/HYBRID/WEB-ASSISTED

STUDENTS:

After registration, go to my.humphreys.edu, click "Moodle" (upper-right box) and sign in to your course by Wednesday of the first week. You will need your student ID number to log on. You can find your ID number on your report card, or call the Registrar's office.

MODALITY:

Course modality describes the method(s) in which class content is delivered. The modalities can be described generally as:

Traditional: Courses meet in class based on scheduled times and course content and activities are delivered in the classroom setting.

Web-Assisted: Courses meet in class based on scheduled times. Course content and activities are generally conducted in the classroom, but certain activities and/or additional course content may be delivered/conducted using the Moodle course management system.

Hybrid: Courses meet both online and in class according to a described schedule. Content and assignments are conducted in both modalities.

Online: Courses are conducted entirely online through the Moodle course management system. All activities are conducted electronically.
