Course Modality

Hybrid: Courses meet both online and virtually on Zoom or on the designated campus, if indicated, according to a described schedule. Content and assignments are conducted in both modalities. Hybrid A Virtual meetings begin Week 1; Hybrid B Virtual meetings Week 2. Class time is scheduled for 6:15-9:45 PM
